

**NEGROES BLAMED FOR RACE RIOTS**

**Tulsa Pythians Pass Resolutions Concerning the Disturbance Here**

**CLAIM PREMEDITATED**

**Find No Excuse for Armed Band of Blacks to Parade City: Uphold Officers**

That the disturbance which was in evidence here last week was premeditated, and that the negroes were the aggressors in the riot, is the belief of the Tulsa Pythians, which passed resolutions concerning the disturbance here last week.

The resolutions were adopted after a long session of the grand lodge, which was held at the hotel where the disturbance occurred. The resolutions were passed by a large majority.

The resolutions declare that the disturbance was premeditated, and that the negroes were the aggressors. It also declares that the white people were the victims of the riot, and that the negroes were responsible for the disturbance.

The resolutions also declare that the negroes were not entitled to any special treatment, and that they should be treated as ordinary citizens. It also declares that the white people should be protected by the law, and that the officers of the law should be upheld.
