

Polygraph Quality Control Report


On July 23, 2020, I was requested to conduct a polygraph quality control review of a polygraph examination that was conducted on Mr. Jimmy Massey (Mr. Massey), date of birth 07/20/1978 by polygraph examiner Kyle Franks (Mr. Franks).

During the review of the polygraph examination, it was determined Mr. Franks used a Utah Zone Comparison Test (ZCT) that has been validated and approved by the American Polygraph Association. It should be noted the Utah ZCT has a reliability rate over 90%.

The review revealed Mr. Franks used the established standards and best practices set out by the American Polygraph Association and the Association of Police Polygraphists. Mr. Franks conducted an acquaintance examination, which is required, formulated the questions in a proper and relevant manner, marked movement of Mr. Massey during the examination, recorded all three zones (Respiration, Electrodermal Activity and Cardio) and collected the necessary physiological data required to make a determination of Mr. Massey's veracity.

This examiner reviewed and scored each chart utilizing both the Utah scoring method and the Empirical Scoring System, which are both approved by the APA and AAPP. The analysis of all five charts revealed Mr. Massey showed NO DECEPTION INDICATED (NDI) when he answered no to the following questions:

- R1 – Did you cause the death of Carina Saunders? (answer "No)
- R2 – Regarding the death of Carina, did you participate in any way? (answer "No)
- R-3 Do you know for sure who caused the death of Carina Saunders? (answer "No)
