J R JENCKS, affiant, being first duly sworn, on oath depose and state that the following constitutes evidence of commission of a crime.

Electronic data including but not limited phone numbers, names, incoming phone calls, outgoing phone calls, incoming text messages, outgoing text messages, pictures, e-mails, and other digital information stored or previously erased that can be recalled from the data source within the phone.

That the above mentioned property is now located as follows:

A Samsung AT&T Model SGH-A927 black cell phone with serial number R2DB777283M which is currently in the custody of the Bethany Police Department and logged in as property number 11P2434.

in the City of Bethany, County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma based on the following facts.

That your affiant is a Lieutenant for the City of Bethany Police Department and is currently assigned to the investigations division and assigned to assist as needed with the multi-agency task force consisting of the Department of Homeland Security/Immigration Customs Enforcement, and other agencies within Oklahoma County. That your affiant has 23 years of experience as a Police Officer within the State of Oklahoma with the majority of that experience being in the investigation of crimes involving the illegal possession, use, distribution, and trafficking of Controlled Dangerous Substance.

That during the month of October and November Officers of the Bethany Police Department were assigned to assist and work with the Department of Homeland Security/Immigrations Customs Enforcement task force. That during that investigation a subject identified as Jimmy Massey, date of birth 07-20-78, who goes by the nickname of "County" or "Big County", was named as one of the persons involved in dealing large quantities of Methamphetamine in the area of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, and other jurisdictions. That it was far reaching and highly structured organization. During the course of that investigation it was determined that the majority of all of the business conducted by this organization was conducted through text messages and voice calls via their personal cell phones. As a result of that investigation arrest warrants were issued for several persons, including Jimmy Massey, date of birth 07-20-78. On November 4, 2011 at about 1918 hours, Jimmy Massey was located in the 3500 blk of SW 29th street in Oklahoma City and taken into custody without incident by members of the DHS/ICE task force, OCPD Officers, and Bethany Officers. At that time Massey's cell phone taken from his person and secured as evidence in the Bethany Police Department Evidence/Property Room.

During the subsequent follow up investigation it was determined that Jimmy Massey had a second phone that he used until he broke it over the weekend of October 7-10, 2011. This broken cell phone, the above listed Samsung Model

SGH-A927 was found in the possession of the wife of Massey. The wife of Massey stated that the AT&T cell phone account that her and her husband's cell phones are on her account. It has also been determined that Massey has some involvement in not only the selling of large quantities of drugs but by his own statements during interview and interrogation has considerable information in regards to the homicide and dismemberment of Carina Saunders during the same weekend of October 7-10. It is believed that there will be information on the cellphone in the form of text messages.

Therefore, I request a warrant to be issued directing the search of the above property for the above items to be used for the further investigation and identification of additional persons involved in the Trafficking and Distribution of CDS.
