On or about December 16, 2021, my laboratory received a sample of what appeared to be carpet padding (Q3). Gross examination of the sample did not suggest the presence of any sort of dried stain. Nonetheless, a cutting from the sample was tested for the presence of human blood using the Hematrace blood detection kit.

Test Results

Gross and microscopic examination of the swatch failed to reveal any evidence of dried blood or other biological material. Serological testing for human blood also failed to reveal the presence of blood on the swatch.
