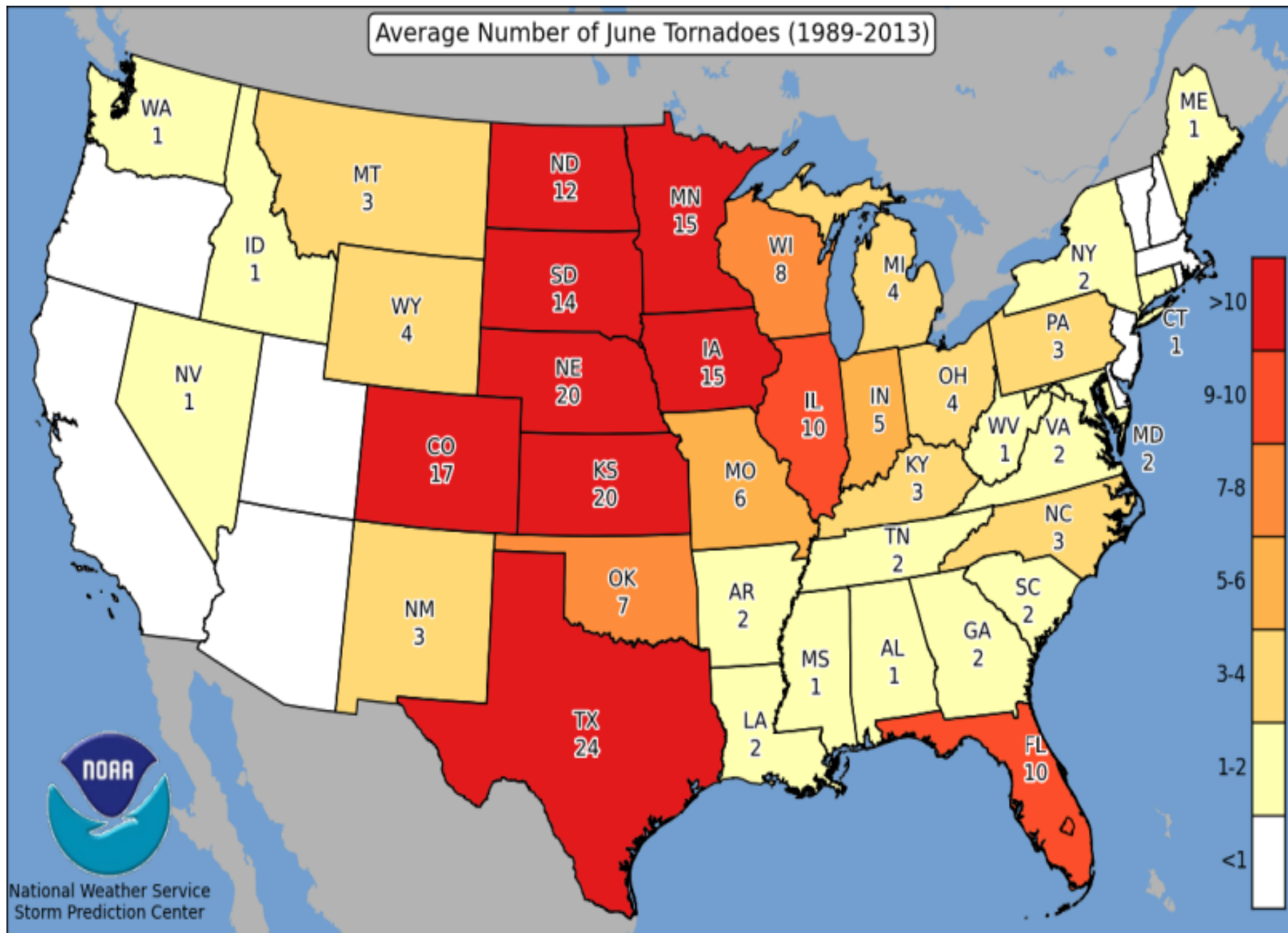

Average Number of June Tornadoes (1989-2013)



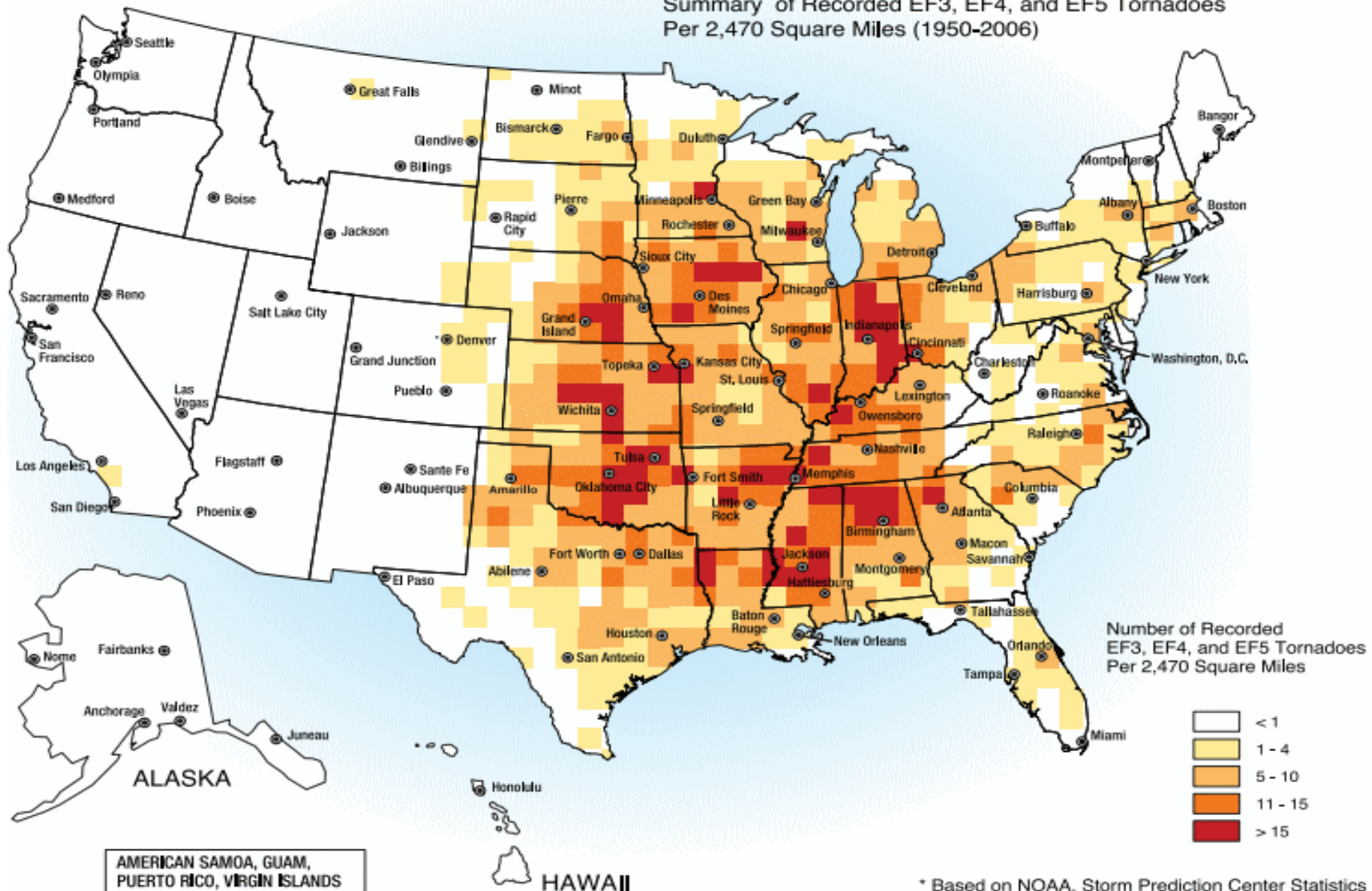
DIAGRAMMATIC REPRESENTATION OF TORNADO ALLEY IN THE USA

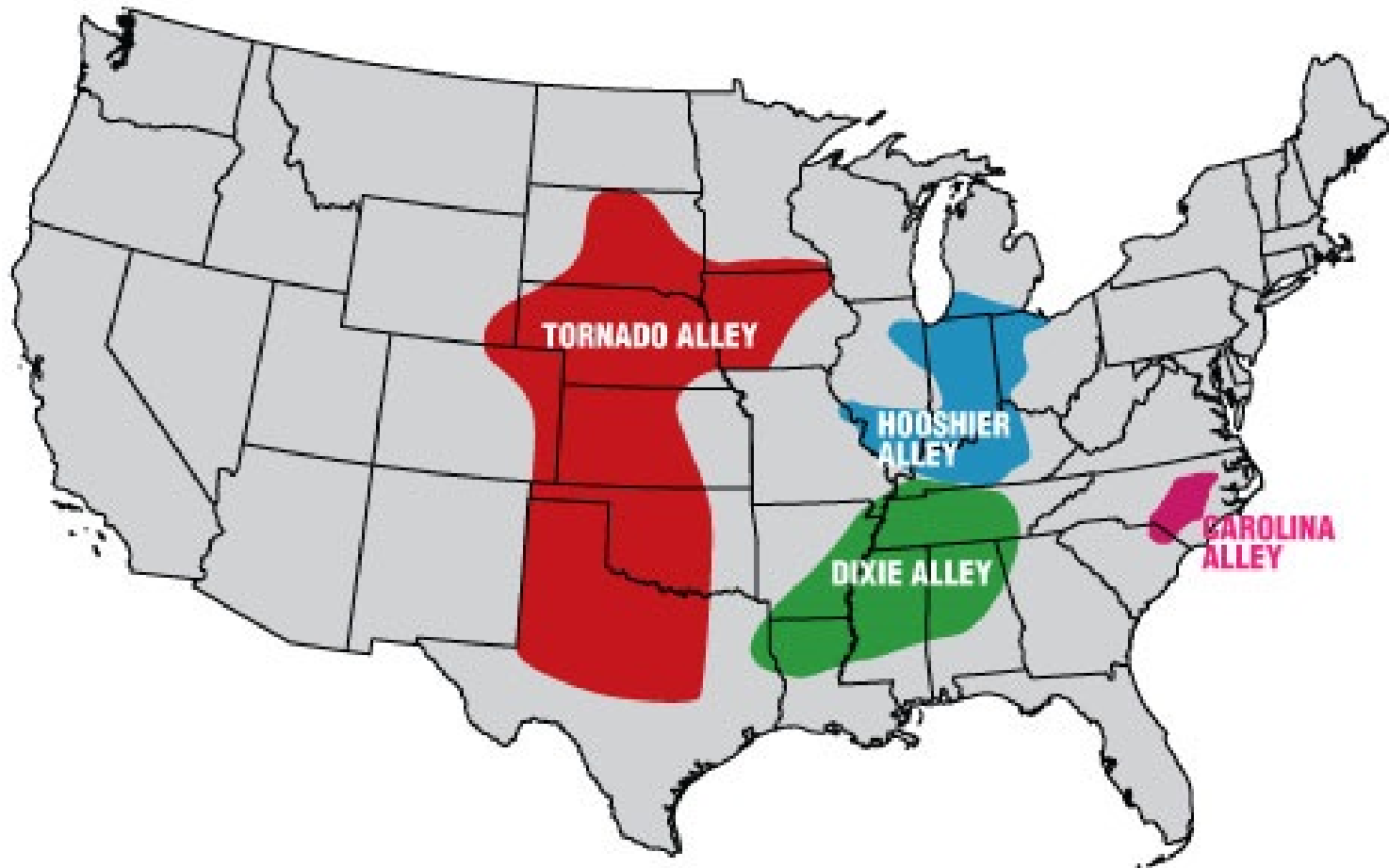
Summary of Recorded EF3, EF4, and EF5 Tornadoes
Per 2,470 Square Miles (1950-2006)



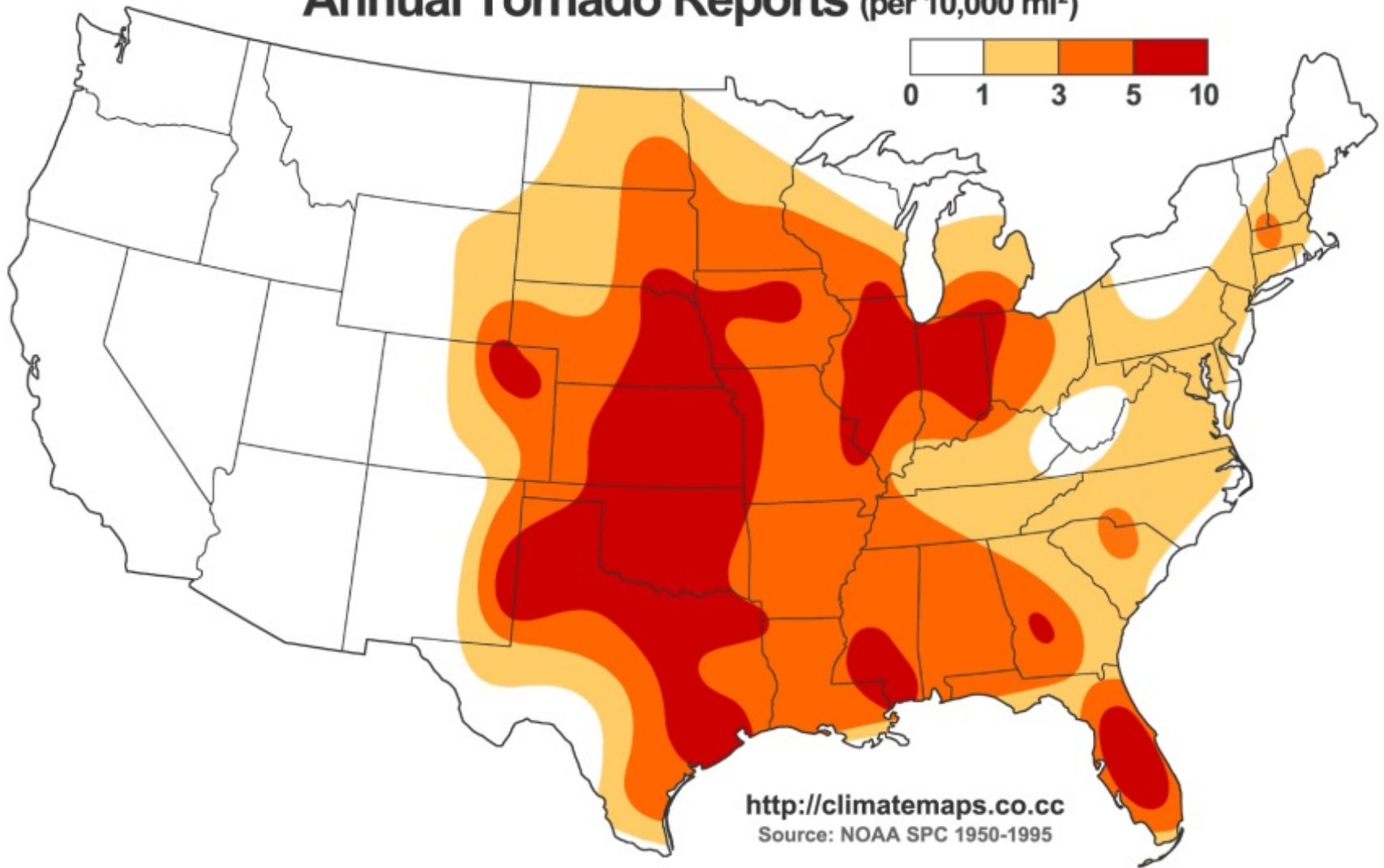

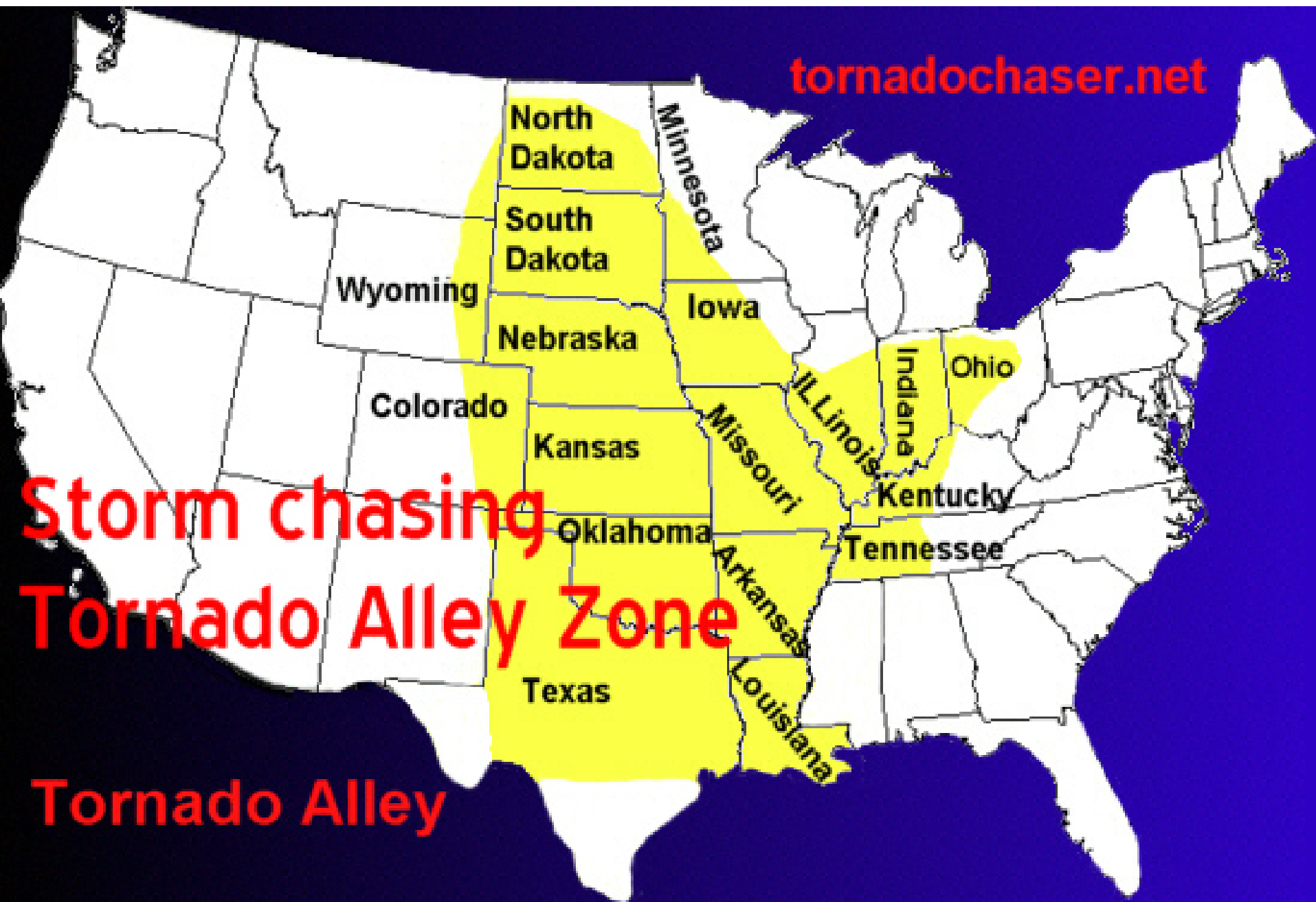
